ACAMPROSATE (Campral) Side Effects:

Most common: diarrhea (dose-related, transient), weakness, swelling of the arms and legs, insomnia, anxiety.

Serious but rare: Acute renal failure reported in a few cases; suicidal ideation, attempts, and completions rare but greater than with placebo in studies.

Pregnancy: Category C. There are no controlled data in human pregnancy. Birth defects and still-born fetuses in animal studies.
