

## SUVOREXANT (Belsomra) Side Effects:

Most common: sleepiness, headache, abnormal dreams, dry mouth.

Serious but rare: impaired alertness and motor coordination, including impaired driving; sleep paralysis (inability to speak or move for up to a few minutes during the sleep-wake transition), hallucinations upon waking or falling asleep, and cataplexy-like symptoms (leg weakness for seconds up to a few minutes both in the nighttime and daytime) reported, especially at higher doses.

Pregnancy: Category C. There are no controlled data in human pregnancy.
