

PRAZOSIN (Minipress) Side Effects:

Most common: sleepiness, dizziness, headache, weakness.

Serious but rare: head rush or lightheadedness upon standing (orthostasis), fainting (syncope); prolonged dangerous erections have been reported (priapism).

Pregnancy: Category C. No controlled data are available in human pregnancy, but studies in which prazosin was administered during human pregnancy show only maternal rapid heart rate (tachycardia) and no teratogenic effects
