

TRAZODONE (Oleptro) Side Effects

Most common: drowsiness, dry mouth, dizziness or lightheadedness, headache, blurred vision, nausea, or vomiting.

Serious but rare: reports of priapism (painful erection >6 hours in duration); may require surgical or pharmacologic (eg, epinephrine) intervention and may result in impotence or permanent impairment of erectile function. Low blood pressure upon standing and fainting (syncope) reported.

Pregnancy: Fewer data show no increased risk of birth defects.
