

PROPRANOLOL (Inderal) Side Effects:

Most common: dizziness, fatigue, slow heart rate (bradycardia), low blood pressure (hypotension), may worsen asthma.

Serious but rare: abrupt withdrawal may worsen heart disease, severe rash

Pregnancy: Category C. Beta blockers may cause decreased blood to the placenta (placental perfusion), fetal and neonatal slow heart rate (bradycardia), and low blood sugar (hypoglycemia).
