

## NALTREXONE (ReVia, Vivitrol)

Most common: headache, nausea, sleepiness, vomiting.

Serious but rare: Dose-related liver problems (hepatocellular injury). Discontinue if signs/symptoms of acute hepatitis develop (nausea, vomiting, fever, pain in the upper right part of the abdomen, and yellow skin).

Pregnancy: Category C. Animal studies have revealed evidence of embryo death when given in doses approximately 30 to 60 times the human therapeutic dose. There are no adequate and controlled study data in human pregnancy.
